Methodology

For the Pure Play Index, a company must generate more than 10% of its revenue from the 3D Printing sector, have a minimum threemonth average daily trading volume (3-month ADTV) of 25,000 euros and a minimum free-float market cap of 10 million euros. All companies that meet these requirements are ranked by free-float market cap. The top 30 companies will be selected for inclusion in the index.
