Bridgeway and Westwood each manage approximately one-half of the Fund's portfolio. State Farm Investment Management Corp. monitors the performance of the sub-advisors.

The Fund invests at least 80% of Bridgeway's portion of net assets (plus borrowings for investment purposes) in stocks from among those in the large-cap growth category at the time of purchase. Under normal market conditions, Westwood invests at least 80% of its portion of the Equity Fund (plus borrowings for investment purposes) in common stocks and other equity securities in large capitalization companies.






